The project aims to uncover and share the strategies driving these successes.

In a post-pandemic world, schools are still working hard to recover lost learning and restabalize education. On average, students need four to five extra months of schooling to catch up, with marginalized students being the most affected.

We analyzed district data from 2019 to 2024, focusing on performance improvements in core subjects.
