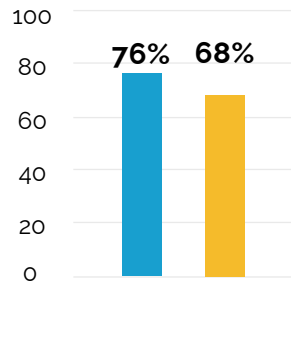
ELA 2019-2023
